The Critical Care Nursing Orientation Program (CCNOP) offers comprehensive training to fully prepare you to work with critically ill patients in ICU and additional support as you transition into your new team.

Course Requirements

Open to **RNs** and **LPNs** with at least one year of acute care experience in medicine, surgery, cardiac care, or emergency.

Completion of an approved cardiac rhythms course is required prior to the start of the CCNOP. Accepted applicants requiring cardiac rhythms education will be enrolled in the CCNOP Cardiac Rhythm Course scheduled one week prior to the CCNOP start date.

How it works



Guaranteed job in Critical Care: apply directly to preferred ICU (at hospital of your choice) as a nurse trainee and start on the unit upon completing your training.



Comprehensive Training: you will participate in theory and lab training, with in-unit experience and clinical orientation supported by experienced nurse educators to fully prepare you for your new role.



Accessible Education: blending online and classroom learning followed by hands-on experience through a specialized clinical practicum in the unit where you will work upon graduation. Lab and clinical (buddied and specialized) experience are important to the CCNOP program.



Paid Training: You will be paid a full-time salary throughout your comprehensive training.
