

CPSM¹ Quick Guide for International Medical Graduates

FOLLOW THE STEPS BELOW

To apply for Provisional Registration (Family Practice Limited) with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Manitoba (CPSM) through the College of Family Physicians of Canada (CFPC) Recognized Training and Certification from Outside Canada Route

1. The College of Family Physicians of Canada (http://www.cfpc.ca) recognizes training and certification from four approved jurisdictions. They are Australia, Ireland, United Kingdom and the United States of America. Review CFPC's requirements for Recognized Training and Certification From Outside Canada route https://www.cfpc.ca/en/education-professional-development/examinations-and-certification/alternative-pathways-to-certification-in-family-me/recognized-training-in-certification-outside-canad and complete the online self-assessment questionnaire https://ca.surveygizmo.com/s3/50054258/AEG-English-Enhancement. If upon completion of the self-assessment you are eligible to apply for the recognized training route, you may begin the application process at the end of the self-assessment.



Request that CFPC provide CPSM with a copy your letter confirming your eligibility for certification without examination.

- 3. Open a <u>physiciansapply.ca</u> account. Physiciansapply.ca is a safe on-line web portal operated by the Medical Council of Canada. Services provided by physiciansapply.ca include:
 - <u>Source Verification of Required Documents</u>. The following documents <u>must</u> be submitted and source verified by physiciansapply.ca:
 - Medical school diploma
 - Internship
 - Postgraduate training
 - Specialty certificate(s) (if applicable)
 - Registration/Licensure certificates (in all jurisdictions outside of Canada and the U.S.)
 - Application for Medical Registration with the Medical Regulatory Authority for that jurisdiction
 - Application for Medical Council of Canada Exams
