They work as part of an interprofessional team to deliver care to seniors and individuals with medical conditions, post-surgery or with developmental disabilities.



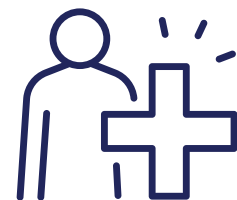

Nursing Assistant

Are you a trained health care aide looking to expand your skills?

Red River College Polytechnic offers a four-month Health Unit Clerk course which will help you build the skills required to work as a nursing assistant!

The role of nursing assistant combines many of the duties of a health care aide with the addition of clerical responsibilities, such as maintaining patient records and processing orders.



Operating Room Assistant

Are you a trained health care aide with at least three years of recent experience working in an acute care environment?

You may be eligible to enroll in a comprehensive 12-week paid training program to become an operating room assistant! This program will prepare you for a full-time role working alongside surgical team members. You will use your skills to contribute to the delivery of safe and effective care for patients undergoing a surgery or procedure.
