

Manitoba Locum Tenens Program

The Manitoba Locum Tenens Program (MLTP) is designed to provide locum coverage to rural and northern (outside of Winnipeg & Brandon) physicians in practices of four physicians or less, as well as urban (within Winnipeg & Brandon) physicians in practices of ten physicians or less. These physicians experience difficulty in scheduling Continuing Medical Education and vacation time as locums are frequently in short supply. Locums in the rural & northern program are ordinarily allocated between 5 and 28 days. Locums in the urban program can be allocated from 5 days to 17 weeks

Rural & Northern Locum:

- New Graduates a chance to explore a variety of different rural communities and practices;
- Short term commitments; from 5 to 28 days
- Competitive daily stipend plus all applicable Regional Health Authority on-call and other service fees
- Travel time honoraria of up to \$200 one way plus travel expenses
- Accommodations
- Mileage to and from assigned community

Urban Locum:

- Wide variety of practice within Winnipeg and Brandon
- Placements of 5 days to 17 weeks
- FFS Model Compensation and 15% overhead hold back.
- Provision of office staff and clerical support
- Online locum assignment matching
- Online locum searches
- Online dashboard to manage locum applications and assignments

CRITERIA:

- Licensed and registered to practice in Medicine in Manitoba (CPSM)
- A member in good standing with the CMPA
Canadian Medical Protective Association
- Certification in Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS) and Advanced Trauma Life Support (ATLS) or willingness to obtain certification.
