Role Requirements

- Medical laboratory assistants spend a lot of time either sitting or standing
- Medical laboratory assistants perform repetitive tasks
- Medical laboratory assistants must follow strict safety procedures to keep themselves safe from hazardous materials
- Medical laboratory assistants may be responsible for phlebotomy (taking blood from patients)
- Medical laboratory assistants generally work 8-hour shifts, including days, evenings, nights, weekends, and holidays

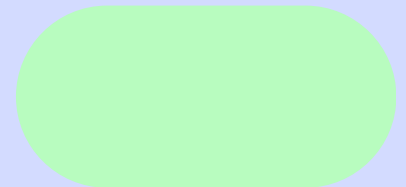
