

FOLLOW THE STEPS BELOW

To apply for Provisional Registration - Family Practice Limited with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Manitoba (CPSM) through the College of Family Physicians of Canada (CFPC) Recognized Training and Certification from Outside Canada Route

The College of Family Physicians of Canada (https://www.cfpc.ca/en/home) recognizes training and certification from four approved jurisdictions. They are Australia, Ireland, United Kingdom and the United States of America. Review CFPC's requirements for Recognized Training and Certification From Outside Canada_route (<a href="https://www.cfpc.ca/en/education-professional-development/examinations-and-certification/alternative-pathways-to-certification-in-family-me/recognized-training-in-certification-outside-canad) and complete the online self-assessment questionnaire (https://ca.surveygizmo.com/s3/50054258/AEG-English-Enhancement). If you are eligible to apply for the recognized training route, you may begin the application process at the end of the self-assessment.



Request that CFPC provide CPSM with a copy your letter confirming your eligibility for certification without examination.

- 2. Review CPSM's requirements for Provisional Registration Family Practice Limited (https://cpsm.mb.ca/registration/registration-requirements/provisional-registration-family-practice-limited)
- 3. Open a <u>physiciansapply.ca</u> account. Physiciansapply.ca is a safe on-line web portal operated by the Medical Council of Canada. Services provided by physiciansapply.ca include:
 - Source Verification of Required Documents. The following documents <u>must</u> be submitted and source verified by physiciansapply.ca:
 - Medical school diploma
 - Internship
 - Postgraduate training
 - Specialty certificate(s) (if applicable)
 - Registration/Licensure certificates (in all jurisdictions outside of Canada and the U.S.)
 - Application for Medical Registration with the Medical Regulatory Authority for that jurisdiction



Share your documents with CFPC and CPSM through your physiciansapply.ca account.

4. Register as an International Medical Graduate (IMG) with Health Careers Manitoba (https://healthcareersmanitoba.mua.hrdepartment.com/hr/ats/JobSearch/index). Health Careers Manitoba is a one-stop shop for physicians looking for employment opportunities in Manitoba. Scan the QR Code for physician opportunities within the province.
