#### **Role Requirements**

- Sonographers may need to hold different positions while performing scans and must be mindful of muscle strain
- Sonographers may work with patients who experience medical test anxiety
- Sonographers may be required to travel to provide services in other facilities or smaller rural communities
- Diagnostic medical sonographers work 8-hour shifts, including days, evenings, weekends, and holidays. Some work overnight call shifts.
